Discuss nuanced topics about how you and your fellow players experience and navigate a variety of situations

P Card Type | QUESTION

The most common card type!
Answer the question to the best of your understanding, ability, and comfort level.

You are only answering on behalf of yourself, and your answers may differ from the rest of the group. That's okay!

? Card Type | RAPID FIRE

As a group (starting with the current player, and continuing clockwise), list as many answers to the prompt on the card as you can, within 30 seconds.

Don't panic, and feel free to pass if you need to!

? LEVEL 1

BE CURIOUS

Learn about the people you're playing with and the experiences and relationships that have shaped them

? LEVEL 3

BE BOLD

Delve deeper into complex issues to discover things you may not have known about one another, or even yourself

Card Type | HYPOTHETICAL

Imagine yourself in the scenario outlined on the card and describe how you would feel or react to the situation.

Even if you have never, or could never, be in that scenario, do your best to imagine how it might play out!

? Card Type | PICTOBANG

All players will each (simultaneously) draw a picture that reflects the prompt on the card, within 30 seconds.

These prompts are meant to be somewhat open and abstract, so draw the first thing that comes to mind!

P InterroBang | QUESTION

Share your own answer
OR

Ask a follow up question



SUGGESTED QUESTIONS:

- Do you think this has or will change over time?
- How could this be influenced by age/race/beliefs etc?
- Where could you learn more about this topic?

? InterroBang | RAPID FIRE

Share an observation from the round OR

Ask a follow up question



SUGGESTED QUESTIONS:

- Was it easy or difficult to think of responses?
- Were there any notable or surprising responses?
- Did you disagree with any of the responses?

InterroBang | HYPOTHETICAL

Share how you would feel or react $$\operatorname{\textsc{OR}}$$

Ask a follow up question



SUGGESTED QUESTIONS:

- \bullet Was your answer informed by any experiences?
- What reaction do you think your actions would get?
- What potential risks could arise in this scenario?

Take turns describing your drawings

AND

Discuss the difference and similarities



SUGGESTED QUESTIONS:

- How many ways could the prompt be interpreted?
- What influenced your interpretation of the prompt?
